Instructions

- Abstracts can only be submitted electronically through this website, and thus not by letter, fax or email.
- The abstract must be written in English.
- The abstract may contain a maximum of 4 000 characters (including spaces and excluding the title and contact information of authors).
- A limited number of pictures (1) or tables (1) are allowed to be included in the abstract.
- The following structure of the abstract is recommended:
 1. Purpose
 2. Method
 3. Results
 4. Conclusions

Other information

- It is the author's responsibility to submit a correct abstract. Any errors in spelling, grammar, or scientific fact will be published as typed by the author, if accepted.
- Poor English may be a cause for rejection.
- The authors must have ethical permissions for all presented experiments that include work with humans or animals.
- All abstract authors participating in the congress are committed to make their poster or demo presentation in the time slot allocated by the Programme Committee. There will be a First and a Second session for poster and demo presentations.
- The submitting author will receive all correspondence concerning the abstract and is responsible for informing the other authors of the status of the abstract.
- Acknowledgement of abstract receipt will be sent to the email address given. If you do not receive this confirmation within 24 hours of submission, please contact Carlson Wagonlit Meetings & Events at neuroinformatics2010@carlsonwagonlit.se
- Notification of acceptance/rejection of the abstracts will be emailed in mid-May 2010.

- All authors should be aware that the abstract and all author names will be published online with Frontiers in Neuroinformatics.
